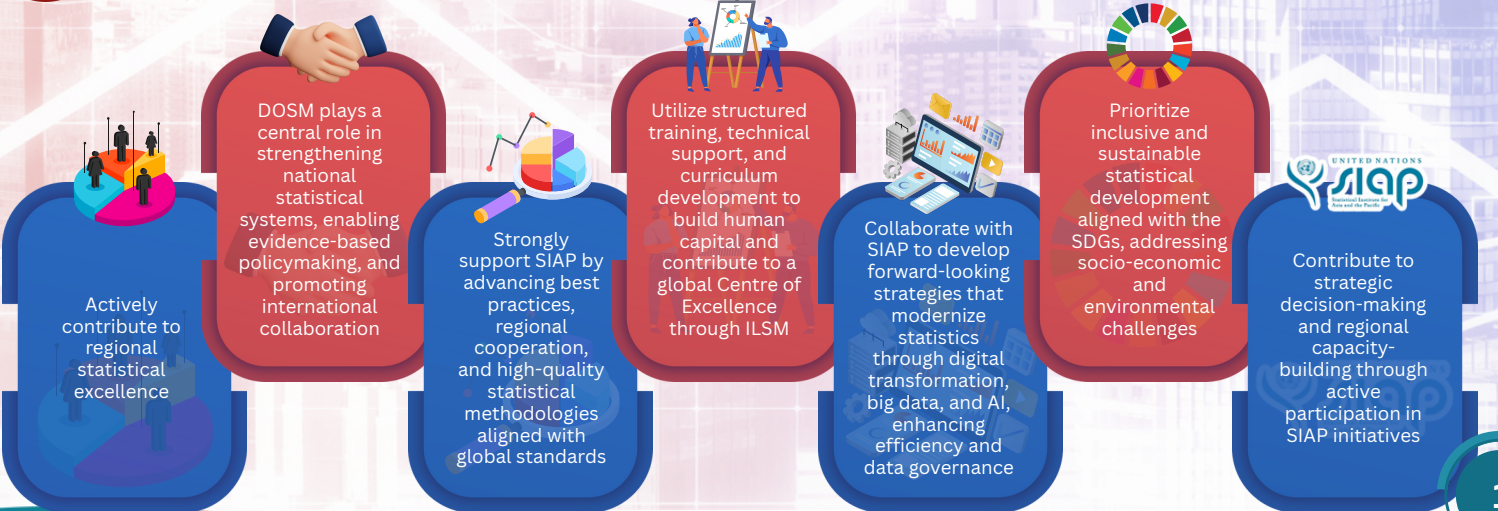

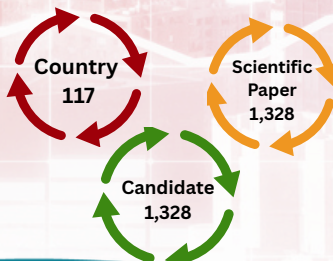

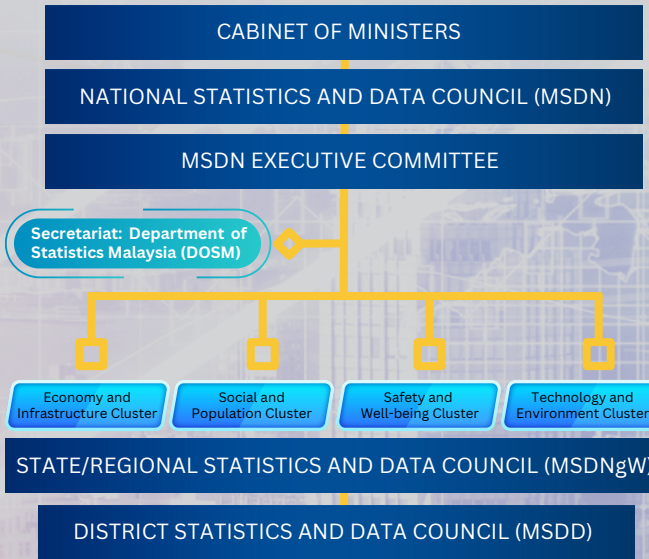


Standardization of Statistical Classification



NATIONAL STATISTICS AND DATA COUNCIL (MSDN)

In 2020, the Government of Malaysia agreed to the establishment of the National Statistics and Data Council (MSDN), chaired by the Prime Minister of Malaysia. The MSDN serves as the highest advisory body in providing guidance and direction to strengthen the governance of the National Statistical System. The MSDN Governance Structure is also supported by the establishment of the MSDN Executive Committee, the State/Regional Statistics and Data Council, and the District Statistics and Data Council.

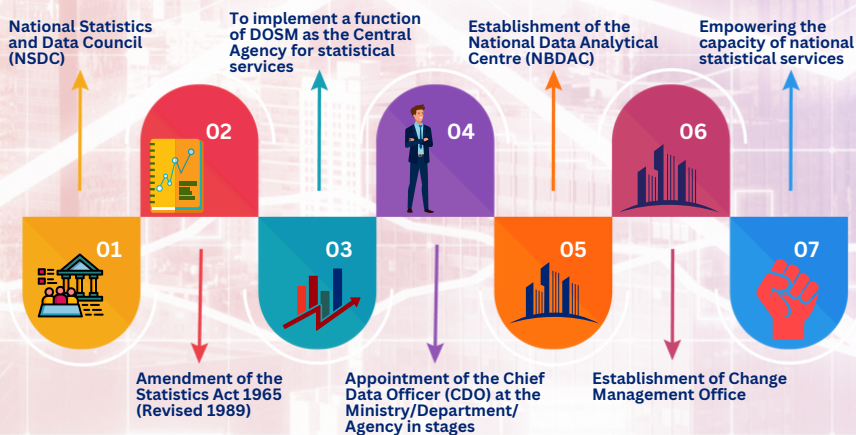
Introduction

Objective

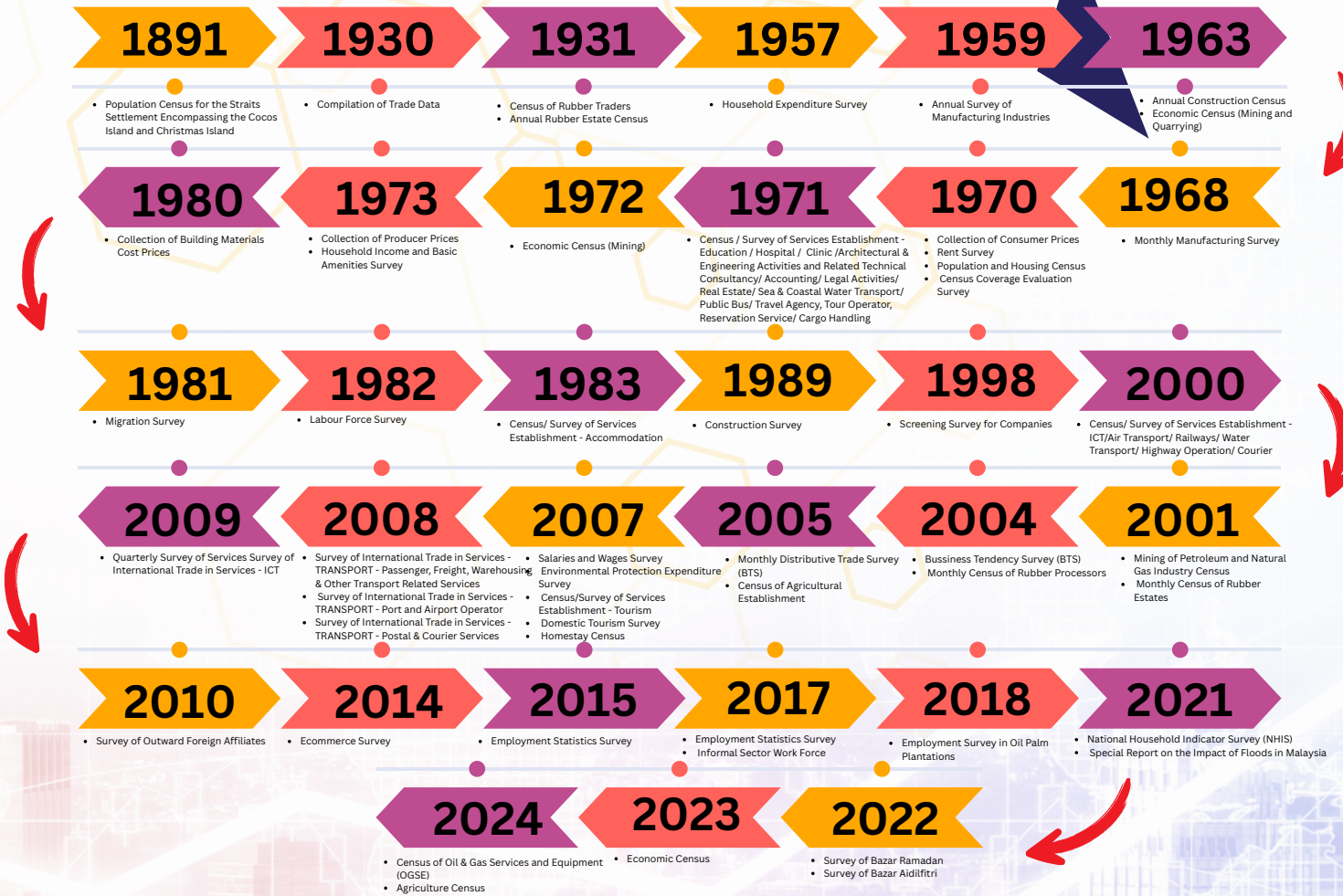

Main Agenda of the National Statistical System (PSSN)



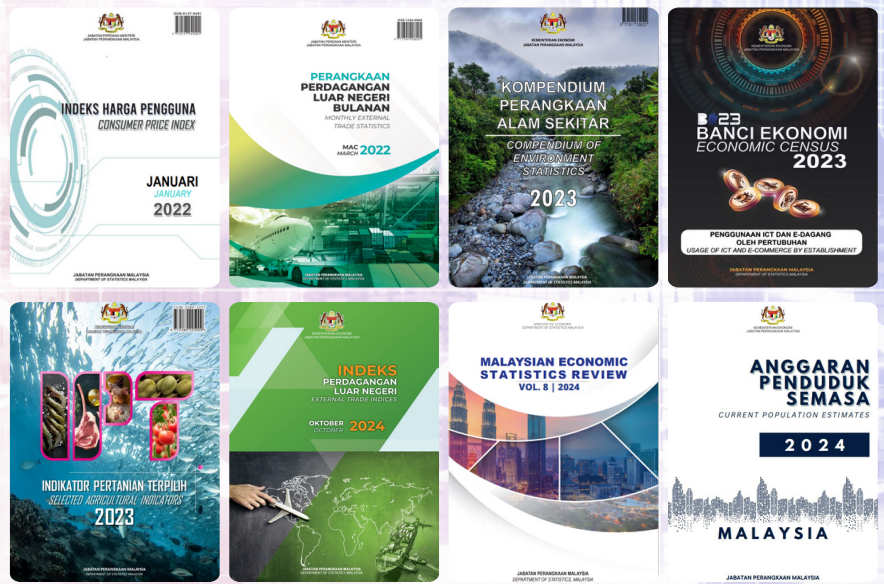

ILSM was established to fulfill the needs of the **development of human capital in the DOSM** as well as to raise awareness and understanding of the importance of statistics among society.

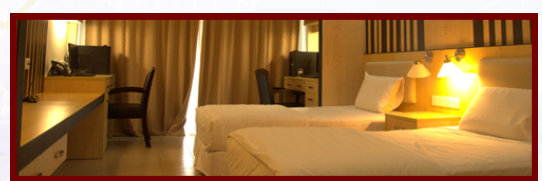

CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT



The Institute in Sungkai, Perak Darul Ridzuan was built on 40.5 acres of land, starting on 15 May 2008. It includes an administration block, accommodation block, multipurpose hall, surau, and recreational facilities. Development was done in two phases: the first phase (admin and accommodation blocks) was completed on 28 December 2011, and the second phase (hall, surau, and director's house) was completed on 27 June 2014. ILSM began operations on 3 January 2012 with 28 staff.

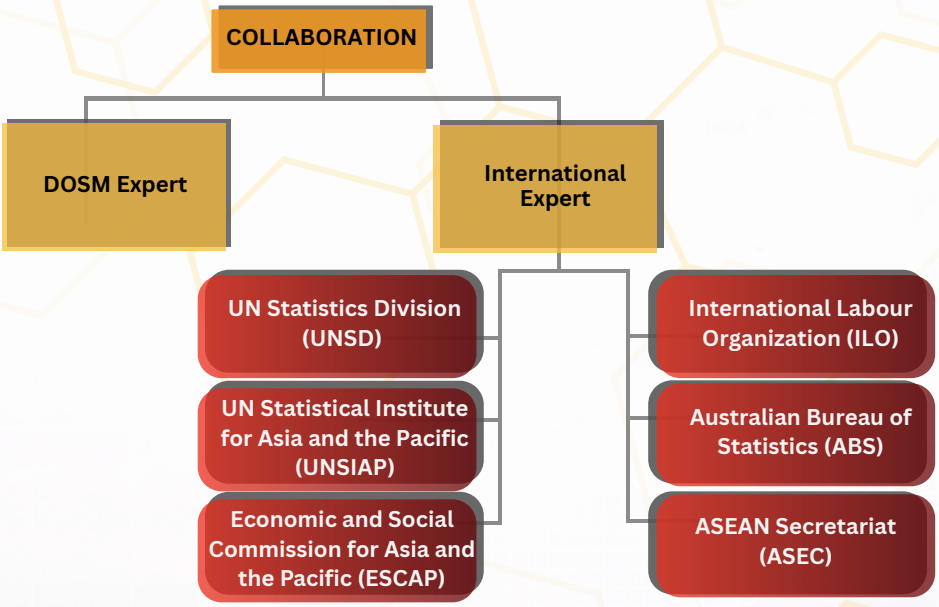
