Chart 1: Demographic statistics first quarter (Q1) 2018, Malaysia

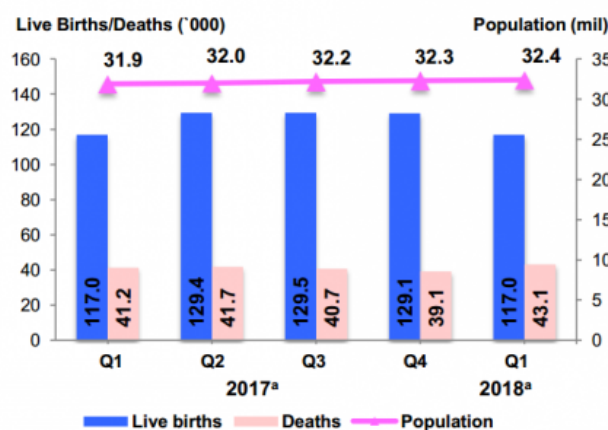
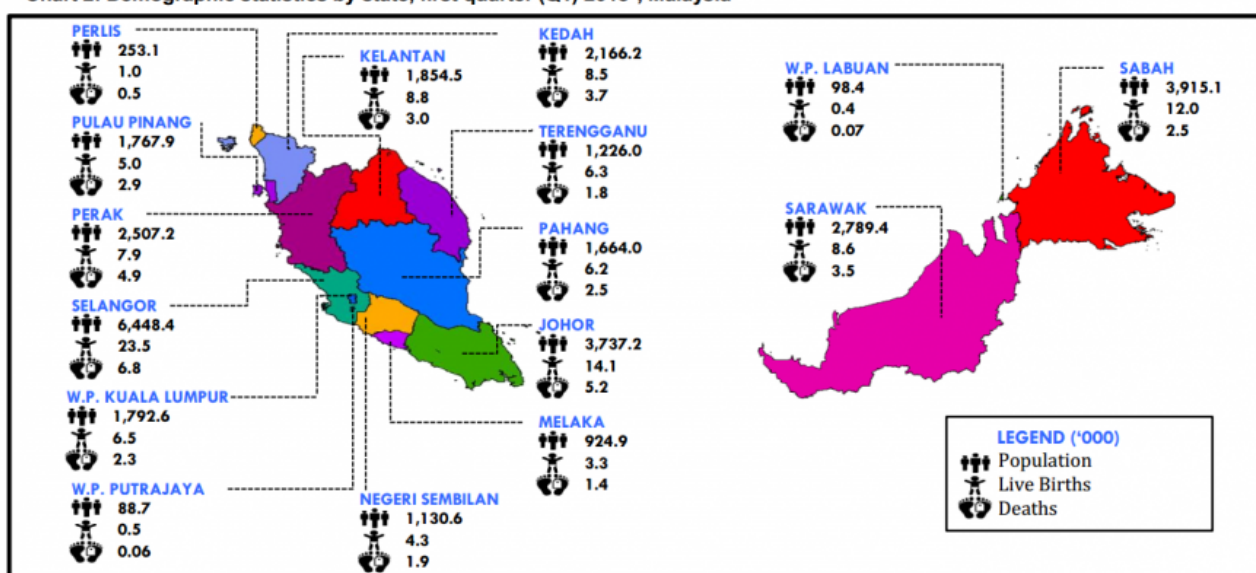


Chart 2: Demographic statistics by state, first quarter (Q1) 2018^a, Malaysia

Chart 3: Number of live births and deaths by quarter, 2010–2018, Malaysia

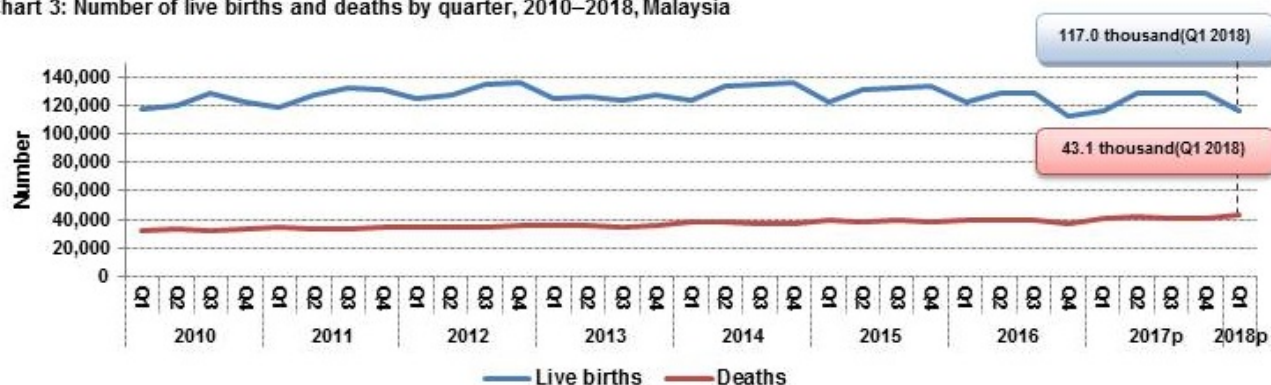
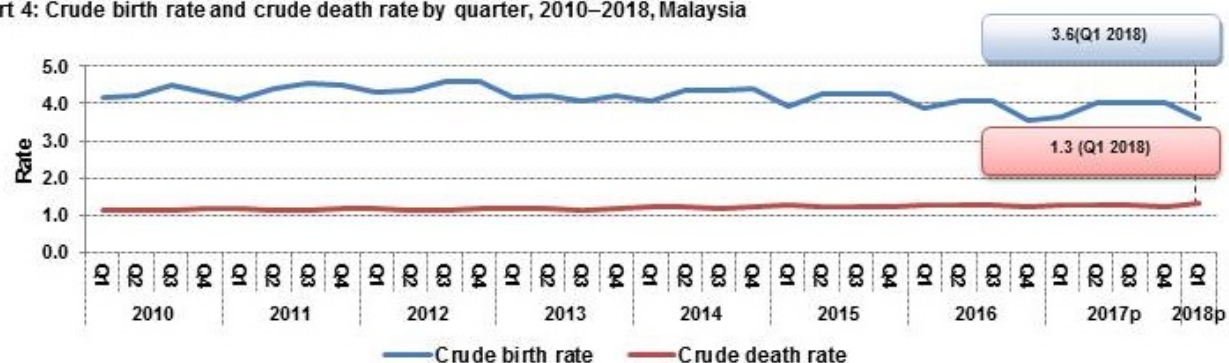


Chart 4: Crude birth rate and crude death rate by quarter, 2010–2018, Malaysia
